Fees

The Florida States Festival charges us \$150.00 per student attending.

If you did not fundraise this year, your fee is \$80.00.

If you fundraised this year, your fee is only \$40.00.

If you super-fundraised (over \$200), then your fee is FREE.

If you sign up to go to States, and then do not attend due to a choice you have made, you must reimburse the Thespians Treasury for the remaining non-refundable amount we paid to the International Thespian Society on your behalf.

Competition Workshops

If competing in a States event, you agree to continue rehearsing and refining your piece on your own, using the judges' comments from Districts as a foundation. You will attend a workshop in January, February, and March to continue developing your piece. We will have a meeting of all competitors during Thespians Homeroom on Jan 9, 2019.

Travel

You must have your parent fill out a permission form for you to travel to the Tampa Bay Convention Center and Performing Arts Center by private vehicle.

Commitment

Be sure you are serious about competing! If you are not serious about it - you may be taking a competition space from someone who <u>is</u> serious. If your performance or design group withdraws from competition, <u>you</u> must pay the \$30.00 Drop fee that States assesses us AND you will not be considered for cast, design team, or on-stage crew for the next production; if you are a Senior, you will not graduate with Thespian Honors.

Meals

You will be responsible for providing or purchasing your own meals on this trip.

Attendance

You are expected to attend all 3 days of the States Festival. We do not want to spend Thespian money on days of a field trip that you are not attending.

Grades

You must have no F's, and no more than one D at the end of Quarter 2. We will do another check on March 15, 2019 for your Quarter 3 grade. If you have any F's or more than one D at that time, you will not be permitted to attend States, and any events you are enrolled in will be dropped. You will also be responsible for reimbursing the Treasury for any portion of your registration fee that the troupe paid on your behalf. You are a STUDENT FIRST, and a THESPIAN SECOND.
